Updated SELF-REJUVENATING Form: *Jun. 04, 2011 and PRESENT.*

Dear Dedicated Midwest Individual, Business and/or Institution:

Thank you for participating (or considering participation) in the FREE, Midwest **Operation Relief** Effort! Consequently, to ensure that the greatest amount of **Fiscal donations, Canned Food, unused Kids Winter Clothes, new Toys, lightly-used Toys, and soldier Care Packages** gets distributed to the largest number of persons encompassing the Midwest areas, Operation Relief is immediately providing you with these *definitive* "Plans And Procedures" around this year's collection endeavor. **Hence, please CONTINUE to REFER to this paperwork.** And, do NOT hesitate to contact Operation Relief if you have any further questions.

WHEN TO START AND STOP COLLECTING DONATIONS?

As the general YEAR-AROUND Operation Relief assistance program, our "*Code Able Foster*" troop Care Packages drive, and our children's Fall/Winter "*Tidings 4 Tikes*" campaign is/are **ESPECIALLY** working towards **helping both families and youths in the major *Thanksgiving through December* assistance seasons**, Operation Relief kindly requests that all Operation Relief participants **start NO LATER than September 1st of the *current* year.** (If not sooner.)

To these ends, **all collections should be into FULL-GEAR around the "*Back To School*" through Fall/Winter SHOPPING crowds of the *current* year.** And, complete Operation Relief endeavors should likewise *end* by Dec. 10th of the *current* year.

WHEN TO CALL FOR A FREE DONATION PICK-UP (OR DROP-OFF)?

If you or your Milwaukee, Wisconsin (or surrounding) business/institution has collected ten (10) or more donations, please refer to the "*Need A Free Donation Pick-Up Or Drop-Off Receipt*" section of this paperwork for further assistance. Then, immediately contact Operation Relief (*at the end of these Plans/Procedures*) **at LEAST twelve (12) hours in advance** for a donation pick-up (*or drop-off*) around the following circumstances:

- 1. When you have ten (10) or more donations.**
- 2. BEFORE** Dec. 10th, the last day of the yearly Operation Relief effort.

GENERALLY ASSISTING YOUR DONATION PICK-UP OR DROP-OFF

As Operation Relief commonly uses standard vehicles around our small pick-up staff, Operation Relief asks that, **WHENEVER POSSIBLE**, you place your donations (of ten or more items) into plastic bags or flexible packing/cardboard boxes for easier shipping and receiving to the Salvation Army Distribution Center and others. Then, refer to the "*Need A Free Donation Pick-Up Or Drop-Off Receipt*" section of this paperwork.

WHAT TO DO WITH LESS THAN TEN (10) DONATIONS?

As a general rule of thumb, The Salvation Army and others ONLY picks-up LARGE number donations. Likewise, as Operation Relief consists of a finite amount of volunteers, Operation Relief ONLY picks-up donations totaling ten (10) or more items. **Hence, for donation totals LESS than ten (10), please use ONE of the following procedures:**

1. If you are part of a “Chain” or “Franchise” business/institution participating in the yearly Relief effort, physically MERGE your donations with ANOTHER store/location (in your “Chain” or “Franchise”) who is also participating, so that your contributions effectively EQUAL ten (10) items or more. Then, refer to the “*When To Call For A Free Donation Pick-Up*” section of this paperwork for a timetable.

-- OR --

2. Refer to this paperwork’s “*Need A Free Donation Pick-Up Or Drop-Off Receipt*” section for a timetable. Then, physically drop-off your donations of nine (9) items or less at Operation Relief. (NOTE: *Our Collection Point is located at the END of these Plans/Procedures.*)

NEED A FREE DONATION PICK-UP OR DROP-OFF RECEIPT?

Please know that Operation Relief is giving out donation receipts (for ten items or more), UPON REQUEST, for on-site pick-ups (at Milwaukee, Brookfield, and other surrounding locations) and drop-offs at Operation Relief. (NOTE: *Our Collection Point is located at the END of these Plans/Procedures.*) **Hence, IF you need a donation receipt, here is what you MUST do:**

1. Physically count (or estimate) the individual category amount(s) of Currency, Food, Kids Winter Clothes, Toy, and/or Care Package donations that you have ready for pick-up or drop-off.

2. Estimate how much YOU think that ALL of the individual category/categories of Currency, Food, Kids Winter Clothes, Toy, and/or Care Package donations are worth.

*3. Voice-mail or E-MAIL Operation Relief (*at the end of these Plans/Procedures*) with this information **at LEAST twelve (12) hours in advance**. Consequently, *PLEASE* include your personal name, your institution’s name (*if applicable*), your location’s address, your location’s phone number, your location’s fax number, an *active* e-mail address, your location’s amount of donated items, and how much you believe your donated items are worth. <NOTE: *This way, Operation Relief can have a Tax-statement effective Donation Receipt READY for you when Operation Relief picks-up your donations OR you drop-off donations at Operation Relief.*>

WHAT IS THE CDA ONLINE COMMUNITIES?-

Originally started in 1984 as an Umbrella (or Medium) Association around the various HUMANITIES and HUMANITARIAN endeavors, The CDA Online is an 'OPEN,' not-for-profit Network Resource that both electronically and physically works with the local communities and/or their national charities.

WHO IS IN THE CDA ONLINE COMMUNITIES?-

Since The CDA Online is an OPEN Network Resource, there is NO active membership roster; as participants (including everyday citizens, business leaders and military personnel) are welcome to come and go as they wish. To these ends, 95% of our meetings AND communications are handled Online; as the other 5% of our efforts regularly encompass volunteer field work and/or donations collecting (for establishments INCLUDING The Salvation Army, Food For Families and others).

WHO IS THE FOUNDER OF THE CDA ONLINE COMMUNITIES?-

The founder's name is John K.E. Reed. I (I.e. Mr. Reed) have lived in Milwaukee, Wisconsin since 1969. Besides over twenty-years of Midwest service working with USMC Maj. Brian A. Murray (Ret.) and others, my independent distinctions also include news and short story AUTHORIZING. (Hence, the multilateral 'CDA' Network name.) In addition, I was a city Educator for more than ten-years. And, my public credits likewise include multiple listings in the various 'Marquis Who's Who' publications throughout America.

WHAT IS THE CDA ONLINE COMMUNITIES' CHARITIES SCHEDULE?-

Generally 365 days a year. However, as HOLIDAY charity planning can often become CONGESTED, The CDA Online's Operation Relief effort annually runs from Sept. 1st to Dec. 10th of EACH year. (NOTE: This schedule is ALSO to MEET with the national 'Back To School' and holiday calendars.)
